GUIDELINES:

- Only elementary and secondary schools in **Ontario** are eligible
- Member poets (except first time members) must be in good standing for a minimum of two consecutive years in order to be eligible to participate in the Poets in the Schools program. Membership fees must be paid in full for both the year the application is being made and the previous fiscal year.
- Only one poet can be requested per school
- Funding is limited and will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis
- Incomplete and/or illegible applications will not be considered for funding.
- Before applying to this program the host must contact the poet to confirm availability and request permission to apply for reading fees on their behalf.
